We will be focusing on securing knowledge in all the phonemes we have previously learnt. In addition we shall be looking at high frequency words (HFW), tricky words and alien words.

Homework

- Mathematics shall be set on a Monday and a Friday. Your child’s password is the same as last year, if you have forgotten the password please come and see me.
- Your child will receive a list of spellings every Monday to practice for a spelling test which will be on Friday. Please practice these with your child at home with the spellings in a variety of different orders. They will focus on the two phonemes we are focusing on that week.
