The Role of Class Representative

Class representatives undertake a key role. There are usually at least two representatives per class who act as a link between parents of their class and the PTA committee.

They are required to:

- Act as a link between the PTA committee and the parents and encourage parents to support PTA events
- Attend PTA meetings and AGM and read minutes to keep up to date with what is planned.
- Help co-ordinate the class in fundraising activities, seek volunteers for events when needed and provide feedback to the PTA committee after events. With the Summer and Christmas fairs every class is allocated a stall. Class reps are responsible for co-ordinating the preparation, managing a rota of helpers, clearing up and feeding back.
- Organise social activities for parents in their class ranging from coffee mornings to Christmas and end of year parties. Class coffee mornings and parents' evenings are good fun and an effective way of helping parents get to know each other.
- Manage feedback from the class regarding PTA matters (such as fundraising, volunteering and suggestions) and communicate it to the PTA Committee.
- Organise collection for Teachers' Presents - If your class decides it wants to give the teacher and the teaching assistant a Christmas or end of year present/card the Class Reps will organise this.
- Towards the end of the year find at least one lovely volunteer to rep the next year!
